(1924 – 2019)

Sam was born, raised and lived in Washington, DC. He passed away just before his beloved Nationals clinched the 2019 World Series. He was also an avid fan of the Chesapeake Bay. As a teenager he and his dad built a bayside cottage. Their collaboration cultivated his talent for design, carpentry, plumbing, electricals, engineering and fishin'...

Late in life, Sam was reminded of their cherished outpost when he discovered Rock Hall. He loved the setting, the people and spirit of the town. His military career began during World War II in Europe and North Africa and also included two scientific expeditions in Antarctica during the early 1960s. He served in the Army, Navy and Air Force.

Sam retired with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel and rests in peace in Arlington National Cemetery.
